

Global Markets Research Fixed Income : Auction Calendar

Re-opening of 10-year GII 10/30 prints BTC of 1.799x

Post-announcement, WI opened at 3.60/50% with trades circa RM80m printed at 3.55%, 3.53% and 3.45% levels before closing at 3.55/53%. This auction was weaker-thanexpected; notching a BTC ratio below the 2.0x handle with total bids amounting to RM7.20b and saw poor interest when compared to its earlier auction recently in December with bids totaling RM10.48b on solid BTC ratio of 2.619x. The offering of RM4.0b (no private placement) was in line with our forecast. Summary of tender results are as follows:

Bid to Cover: 1.799x High: 3.589% Average: 3.561% Low: 3.500% Cut-off: 15.0 %

This 10Y GII auction saw weaker-thanexpected bidding metrics with short tail reflecting bids at higher levels of the tender range. Nevertheless we opine levels are turning attractive now... The short tail of ~ 2.8bps; was surprising considering the tepid bids submitted; reflecting investors requirements to tender at the higher range. The average yield at 3.561% is way higher and attractive compared to its similar auction which was awarded at 2.986% in December last year. This benchmark when duration-adjusted is seen **attractive** compared to the conventional equivalent i.e. 10Y benchmark MGS 4/31 which was last done at 3.289% levels today. Note that the yearly historical mean spread between the Islamic and conventional 10Y benchmarks is ~ 6bps). Up next on the calendar is the reopening of 5Y MGS 9/25 with our projected issuance size at RM4.5b.
