- USDMYR opened marginally higher by 0.07% at 4.2165. **Daily outlook bullish.**
- · Weekly outlook and monthly outlook bullish.
- We remain bullish over the foreseeable future as FTSE Russell announced that they will make a decision as to whether Malaysia will still be a part of the index on 26 September with investors hedging into this risk event. Nagging US-China trade issues are also likely to support the pair in the medium term.
- Key resistances: 4.2250 (R1), 4.2300 (R2), 4.2350 (R3)
- Key supports: 4.2150 (S1), 4.2100 (S2), 4.2050 (S3)
- Expected range for the day: 4.2150- 4.2250

- GBPMYR opened higher by 0.23% at 5.1480 today. Daily outlook bearish.
- Weekly outlook bullish and monthly outlook bearish.
- We turn bearish on the pair as PM Johnson manages to get the Queen's approval to suspend Parliament which heightens the chances of a no-deal Brexit. Pair is gaining some support at time of writing due to a stronger USDMYR component on risk aversion but faces strong resistance towards 5.1750.
- Key resistances: 5.1650 (R1), 5.1750 (R2), 5.2000 (R3)
- Key supports: 5.1500 (S1), 5.1350 (S2), 5.1200 (S3)
- Expected range for the day: 5.1500-5.1750





- AUDUSD opened unchanged at 0.6734 today. Daily outlook bearish.
- · Weekly and monthly outlook bearish.
- We remain bearish AUD over the short and medium terms due to yo-yoing risk sentiment and nagging global growth concerns which could weigh on commodity prices.
- Key resistances: 0.6750 (R1), 0.6725 (R2), 0.6800 (R3)
- Key supports: 0.6700 S1), 0.6675 (S2), 0.6650 (S3)
- Expected range for the day: 0.6700- 0.6750

Indicative AUDMYR 2.8407





- AUDMYR opened marginally lower at 2.8396 today. Daily outlook mildly bullish.
- Weekly and monthly outlook bearish.
- We are mildly bullish on the pair over the short term due to bullish USDMYR component adding some support on poorer risk sentiment. We remain bearish on the pair over the medium term as continuously dim global growth outlook is likely weighing on the pair.
- Key resistances: 2.8550 (R1), 2.8600 (R2), 2.8650 (R3)
- Key supports: 2.8300 (S1), 2.8250 (S2), 2.8200 (S3)
- Expected range for the day: 2.8300-2.8550

- EURUSD opened flat at 1.1077 today. Daily outlook mildly
 bullich
- Weekly outlook neutral and monthly outlook bearish.
- We are mildly bullish EUR today on lingering poor risk sentiment which may spur safe haven asset seeking. We remain bearish EUR over the medium term as the ECB is expected to ease more aggressively via introduction of large stimulus package next month.
- Key resistances: 1.1100 (R1), 1.1120 (R2), 1.1150 (R3)
- Key supports: 1.1070 (S1), 1.1040 (S2), 1.1020 (S3)
- Expected range for the day: 1.1050-1.1100

- EURMYR opened marginally lower at 4.6708 today. Daily outlook bullish.
- Weekly outlook neutral and monthly outlook bearish.
- We remain bullish on the pair today as USDMYR component is likely to provide some support on continuous USD demand locally. We remain bearish on the pair over the medium term as the ECB is expected to ease more aggressively via introduction of large stimulus package next month.
- Key resistances: 4.6885 (R1) 4.7000 (R1), 4.7100 (R3)
- Key supports: 4.6700 (S1), 4.6500 (S2), 4.6400 (S3)
- Expected range for the day: 4.6700 4.7000

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
