Intraday Thoughts – MYR Neutral

USD/MYR opened little changed at 4.1355 and strengthened slightly to near 4.14 as of writing. The USD attempts to recover further today amid higher US yields after Fed Chair said in an interview that the US economy was at an "inflection point". Some safe haven biddings are likely to support the USD today as investors brace themselves for more government auctions and top-tiered economic data such as US CPI, retail sales and industrial production.

1-Month Outlook - MYR Bearish

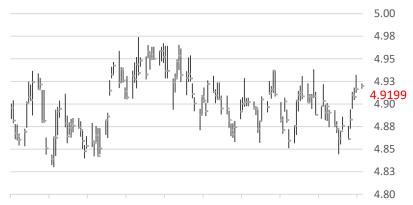
No change to our present view of a stronger dollar which is likely to benefit from higher US yields as the economy recovered further in the US. We continue to expect the dollar to strengthen towards 2Q before trending down in 2H of the year and thus a higher USD/MYR in the medium term.

EUR/MYR Neutral to Bearish

EUR/MYR opened 0.1% higher at 4.9178. We are neutral to slightly bearish on EUR/MYR today as EUR/USD failed to sustain at above 1.19 levels amid the dollar resurgence. Market may turn slightly bearish on EUR on the back of Powell's upbeat comment on the US economy as well.
