Intraday Thoughts – MYR Neutral to Slightly Bearish

USD/MYR opened 0.01% lower at 4.3825 after having closed little changed on Tuesday at 4.3830 (-0.04%). USD/MYR outlook is neutral to slightly bullish, potentially in a range of 4.35-4.40 in our view despite the persistently overbought condition since mid-April. Today's BNM OPR decision and 1Q GDP on 13 May are expected to keep investors on toes. We expect no change in the OPR although markets are turning split on the decision.

1-Month Outlook - MYR Neutral

We expect the MYR to recover some lost ground in the medium term; supported by further economic recovery as the government reopened the Malaysian border on 1st April. Recent rally in global commodity prices coupled with increase in minimum wage to RM1,500 effective 1st May should provide an added impetus along with the advantage of elevated oil prices. We have taken into account the broader USD which is expected to stay firm supported by safe haven demand, Fed rate hike expectations and economic outperformance in the US vis-à-vis other majors. On the flipside, the Russia-Ukraine crisis could potentially derail recovery and policy normalization path.

SGD/MYR Neutral

SGD/MYR opened 0.17% lower at 3.1497. We maintain our view that the cross is expected to continue trading on a neutral note amid cautios sentiment and ahead of today's BNM policy decision. Over the more medium term, the SGD may exhibit a more bullish bias vis-à-vis the MYR underpinned by policy tightening bias from MAS.

GBP/MYR Neutral

GBP/MYR opened 0.25% lower at 5.3939. GBP/USD remains biased towards the downside after having erased Tuesday's early gains amid the strong USD environment. Nonetheless, the daily GBP/MYR outlook is neutral as the GBP market awaits potential catalysts from tomorrow's 1Q GDP data while MYR investors are sidelined by today's BNM OPR decision.

AUD/MYR Neutral

AUD/MYR opened 0.34% lower at 3.0384. We continue to expect the cross to anchor near 4.0500 amid the lack of catalysts as the aussie dollar managed a small recovery this morning and did not react much to China's CPI and PPI inflation data. Dollar strength and the slump in crude oil prices, coupled with the persistent worry over the Chinese growth outlook remained a bane on AUD outlook.
