Intraday Thoughts - Neutral-to-Slightly Bullish

USD/MYR opened 0.16% higher at 4.1480 before paring its gains to trade at 4.1445 at the point of writing. Daily outlook is neutral-to-slightly bullish amid expectations of broad USD strength, supported by haven bid and a stronger than expected US PMI overnight. That said, any further upside beyond 4.1491 (R1) will face significant resistance given that the pair is overbought and amid cautiousness ahead of the upcoming PCE print later in the week.

1-Month Outlook - USD/MYR Neutral

We are neutral on this pair on expectations that investors will stay cautious, waiting for concrete developments on the geopolitical front. Meanwhile, the neutral outlook for the pair will also be supported by expectations that the FOMC will maintain rates (if not tighten) at this level in the near term given that the economy is expanding at a still solid pace, while inflation remains elevated with the latest overrun largely underpinned by energy. In our opinion, persistence fear over inflation will likely keep the Dollar well supported amid a resilient labour market, but growth concerns could likely take centre stage later in the year in anticipation of squeezed corporate profits and consumer spending following the recent run-up in energy prices. On the domestic front, BNM maintained a neutral stance in its latest policy statement, while acknowledging increased risks from the Middle-east conflict. The neutral statement, coupled with BNM's expectation for continued moderate growth (2026: 4.0-5.0%) and benign price outlook (2026: 1.5-2.5%), reinforced our view for an extended OPR pause this year.

USD/SGD Neutral-to-Slightly Bullish

USD/SGD opened flat at 1.2965 and trended up to 1.2968 at the point of writing. For the same reasons above, daily outlook is neutral-to-slightly bullish, facing R1 at 1.2984 (R1) with the pair overbought.

SGD/MYR opened 0.16% lower at 3.1928 before paring its losses to trade at 3.1955 at the point of writing. Daily outlook is neutral-to-slightly bearish given that the pair is slightly overbought and as the softer than expected CPI for Singapore curtails MAS' tightening bets. Next up is Singapore's IPI due for release end week.

GBP/MYR

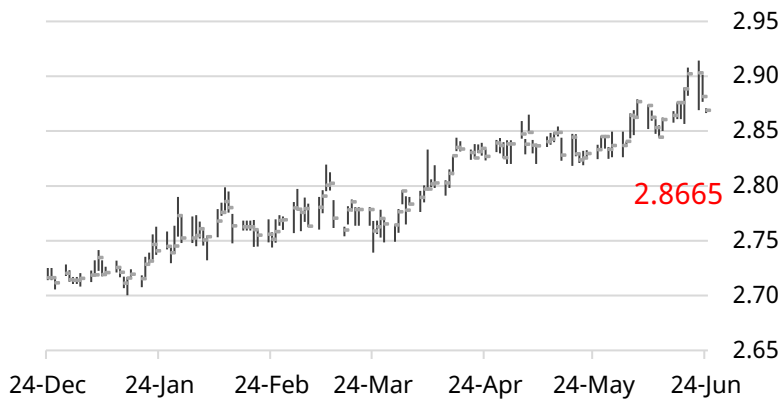


GBP/MYR Neutral-to-Slightly Bearish

GBP/MYR opened 0.08% lower at 5.4752 and slid to 5.4714 at the point of writing. Daily outlook is neutral-to-slightly bearish with GBP/USD trading below 1.3200 at the point of writing after the weak PMIs on the UK front overnight.

AUD/MYR Neutral-to-Slightly Bearish

AUD/MYR opened 0.44% lower at 2.8684 and slid to 2.8665 at the point of writing. Daily outlook is neutral-to-slightly bearish but losses likely capped and to narrow after Australia's core CPI unexpectedly accelerated this morning, keeping RBA on alert in the meantime and supporting AUD.
