



1. SAVE YOUR MONEY WISELY


USE A SAVINGS JAR OR SAVINGS ACCOUNT

Use Secure Websites

Always shop on websites that start with "https://" and have a padlock symbol in the address bar.



Shop from Trusted Retailers

Stick to well-known stores when shopping online to reduce the risk of scams.

EXAMPLE

If you want a new book, buy it from a popular website like MPHOnline.com or a trusted local bookstore's website.

3. PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION IS VALUABLE. HERE'S HOW TO KEEP IT SAFE:



Keep Your Information Private

Never share your personal information with strangers, especially online.

Use Privacy Settings

If you use social media, set your accounts to private so only friends can see your posts.

EXAMPLE

If someone you don't know asks for your address in a chat, ignore them and tell a parent.

5. KEEP AN EYE ON YOUR MONEY

Monitor Your Savings
If you have a savings jar or savings account, check it regularly.



Talk to Your Parents

If you ever feel unsure about something related to your money, talk to your parents or guardians. They can give you advice and help you stay safe.

EXAMPLE

Count your coins each month or check your savings account balance with a parent to stay aware of your money.

4. BE CAUTIOUS WITH EMAILS AND MESSAGES

SCAMMERS OFTEN TRY TO TRICK PEOPLE INTO GIVING AWAY MONEY OR PERSONAL INFORMATION.

Don't Click on Strange Links

If you receive an email or message with a suspicious link, saying you've won a prize and it asks you to click a link, it could be a scam. Don't click on it! Always check with a parent first.




Report Suspicious Messages
