



# 8D7N HOKKAIDO + TOKYO

# Day 1 Kuala Lumpur - Haneda

Assemble at airport for your flight to Japan. Upon arrival, proceed to the hotel.

### Day 2 Haneda - Chitose (By Domestic Flight Approx 1hr 35mins) (L/D)

Early check out from the hotel, transfer to airport to board a domestic flight to Chitose Airport, Hokkaido. Upon arrival at Hokkaido, visit Date Jidaimura (Ninja Village) - a historic theme park highlighting the Edo Period, one of the most attractive eras in Japanese history. Then proceed to Jigokudani (Hell Valley), columns of hot water and steam belching from small crevices, resembling hell and Noboribetsu Hot Spring - best known hot springs in Hokkaido.

### Day 3 Lake Toya - Mt Usuzan – Bear Ranch – Jozankei Onsen (B/L/D)

After breakfast, check out and proceed to visit Lake Toya - Japan's 3rd largest volcanic caldera lake. This ice-free lake never freezes, even in winter when the temperature falls quite drastically. Then, take a ropeway up Mt Usuzan for a scenic view of the active volcano rising from the valley. Enjoy panoramic views of Lake Toya and Mt Showa Shinzan from the observation deck. *(Subject to weather conditions)* After that, visit Bear Ranch (Brown bears are Japan's largest animal and only lives in Hokkaido). Transfer to hotel and overnight stay at Jozankei Onsen Hotel.

### Day 4 Otaru - Shiroi Koibito Park – Sapporo – Tanukikoji (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and proceed check out. Proceed to Otaru which is a small harbour city located northwest of Sapporo City. Continue to Otaru Canal - a picturesque view of century old stone warehouses along the nostalgic canal; Otaru Handicraft Street - renowned for its glass handicrafts, music box museum, art gallery, ice-creams & dessert shops. Then visit Shiroi Koibito Park, factory where the famous Ishiya's chocolate cookies are made. Enjoy shopping at Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade with many shops ranging from souvenirs, cosmetic to clothing. Drive pass Susukino which is Sapporo's most famous nightlife and entertainment area.



# Day 5 Former Government Building – Odori Park - Okurayama – Factory Outlets – Chitose - Haneda (B/L/D)

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Visit Sapporo's landmarks - Hokkaido's Former Government Building and drive pass Clock House. Proceed to visit The Odori Park – a venue for Sapporo Snow Festival & seasonal events. Sapporo TV's Tower and Okurayama features views from the city of Sapporo all the way to the far horizon and is renowned for its ski jump stadium that was used for the Winter Olympics held in Sapporo in 1972. After that, enjoy a Gala Seafood Lunch - presented and prepared by the chef of Hokkaido Kita Gourmet Kitchen at the wet market. After lunch, continue to Factory Outlets - one of the famous factory outlets for branded items on sale. Then, transfer to airport and board a domestic flight to Haneda Airport, Tokyo.

# Day 6 Tokyo – Asakusa Kannon Temple – Ginza – Shinjuku (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Visit Asakusa Kannon Temple - the oldest Buddhist temple in the region. It is one of Tokyo's most colourful and popular attractions. Drive pass the Diet Building and Imperial Palace; home of the Emperor and Empress surrounded by a high stone slab. After that, enjoy shopping at Ginza, known to be a popular upscale shopping district and Shinjuku, one of Tokyo's favorite neighborhoods for shopping and entertainment.

# Day 7 Tokyo Disneyland - Haneda – Kuala Lumpur (B/Japanese BBQ Buffet)
