



6D5N Holi Festival

Day 1 (18/03/2019) Kuala Lumpur – Delhi

Welcome to Delhi International Airport. Meet your driver and transfer to your hotel, and rest of the day free.

Day 2 (19/03/2019) Delhi – Mathura (150kms/ 3-4 hrs drive) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Mathura. On arrival visit the Dwarkadheesh Temple in Mathura to celebrate Holi festival. Head out to Vishram ghat and catch the process of making Bhang (cold flavoured milk) by the priests. If possible, maybe take a glass for yourself as well. The gates of the temple open at 10am and there is already a big crowd outside the gates by then playing Holi and coloring anyone who dares cross the road. Stay overnight at hotel in Mathura/Vrindavan.

Day 3 (20/03/2018) Mathura (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Banke Bihari temple in the morning as the temple opens its doors to all visitors to come and play Holi. The priests throw colours and holy water and the crowd chants madly in unison. It's an unbelievable experience to be a part of this event until the doors of the temple are shut at lunch time. In the afternoon, leave for participate in the colourful Holi procession. The procession starts at Vishram Ghat and get over a little after the Holi Gate. It's best to catch it in the street connecting the two landmarks. About ten vehicles decorated with flowers, and some even with kids dressed up as Radha-Krishna, participate in it. 3pm is a good time to go there and be a part of it. Everyone plays Holi with everyone else and it's futile to resist. Get drenched a few times and get completely coloured and chances are that you will be left to enjoy (or take photographs). Evening Holika Dahan: The evening after the street procession is the time for Holika dehan - or burning of the effigy of Holika. The biggest such effigy is burnt at the Holi Gate and there are many cultural programs as well. Stay overnight at hotel in Mathura/Vrindavan.

Day 4 (21/03/2019) Mathura (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Again today playing holi and throwing colors on everyone. Stay overnight hotel in Mathura/ Vrindavan.

Day 5 (22/03/2019) Mathura – Agra (60kms/02hrs drive) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Agra. On arrival check-in at hotel. Later visit one of the world's most popular monument – Taj Mahal (*it is closed on every Friday*) built by Mughal Emperor Shah- Jehan for his Empress Mumtaz Mahal. Then proceed for sightseeing tour of magnificent Agra Fort- built at the bank of Yamuna River, is situated in the center of the town. Various styles of the architecture are evident within the fort & demonstrate the love of Mughal Emperors towards building beautiful monuments. Stay overnight at hotel in Agra.

Day 6 (23/03/2019) Agra – Delhi (205kms/05 hrs drive) – Departure (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Delhi. On arrival, lunch at local restaurant. Proceed visit to Jama Masjid, India Gate, President House, Parliament House and Humayun Tomb. Early Dinner at local restaurant and transfer to Delhi International Airport for departure.
